# Pacific Provider Development Fund

**Improving Pacific  
community groups'  
access to lottery  
funding**



## What is the Pacific Provider Development Fund?

The Pacific Provider Development Fund is administered by the New Zealand Lottery Grants Board. The Board's role is to benefit the community by distributing the profits from state lotteries.

The Pacific Provider Development Fund is designed to strengthen Pacific community groups' ability to operate in an effective and accountable way, and to improve their access to lottery funding. It supports a partnership approach that best enables groups to succeed.

The Fund is a positive way for the Lottery Grants Board to help the Pacific community receive funding on an equitable basis with other groups. Pacific people, like all New Zealanders, should get a fair share of lottery funding.

Eligible Pacific community groups are welcome to apply for all types of lottery funding – this Fund is just one option. Other options include Lottery Community, Lottery Outdoor Safety, Lottery Environment and Heritage, and the Minister's Discretionary Fund.



## What kind of help is available?

The Pacific Provider Development Fund offers Pacific community groups practical help and encouragement to improve your organisation and processes. This includes:

- ✘ How to organise your group more effectively
- ✘ How to better manage your group's money
- ✘ How to improve leadership and support for your group
- ✘ How to strengthen your group's accountability
- ✘ How to better evaluate your group and the service you provide to the community.

Lottery funding advisors will work closely with applicants who are granted assistance to help them strengthen their skills and resources. Assistance will address the specific needs of each of these applicants and may include:

- ✘ One-on-one support from a lottery funding advisor
- ✘ A needs assessment to determine the best kind of help
- ✘ A development plan to help build a strong range of skills and resources
- ✘ Access to mentors for specific advice and guidance
- ✘ Access to targeted training and skill development.



## Which groups can apply?

The Pacific Provider Development Fund will consider applications for assistance from New Zealand-based Pacific community groups who provide services in New Zealand that primarily benefit Pacific people. Groups' management and membership must also be predominantly of Pacific origin.



## How does my group apply?

To apply for assistance from the Pacific Provider Development Fund, you may like to discuss your plans with a lottery funding advisor. You can contact an advisor through the freephone number at the back of this leaflet.

An information sheet outlines the details of the Fund and the kind of information you will need to provide in making your application. An application form needs to be completed. It requests details about your group and also about the kind of assistance you would like from the Fund. Lottery funding advisors are available to advise you on completing this application.
