Decisions, Legislative Approach and Next Steps

Portfolio: Local Government

On 30 April 2009, the Cabinet Committee on Implementation of Auckland Governance Reforms (AGR):

- 1 **noted** the presentation by the Minister of Local Government on *Auckland Governance: Decisions, Legislative Approach and Next Steps*;
2. **noted** the proposal that there be three Auckland Governance Bills, and that:
 - 2.1 a paper would be submitted to Cabinet on 4 May 2009 seeking policy approval to the content of the first two Bills;
 - 2.2 papers would be submitted to Cabinet on 11 May 2009 relating to appointments to the Establishment Board, and seeking approval to introduce the Auckland Governance Bills;
- 3 **noted** that the report referred to in paragraph 2.1 above would include a consideration of whether water integration issues should be included in the first or the second Auckland Governance Bill.
