

Amendment to the Rules of Casino Table Games

Division 6 - Caribbean Stud Poker

Pursuant to section 367 of the Gambling Act 2003 the following amendment to Division 6 of the Rules of Casino Table Games (Caribbean Stud Poker) was prescribed on 23 October 2009.

This amendment changes the operation of the progressive jackpot pay-table from fixed dollar amounts to a ratio.

This rule came into effect on 30 October 2009.

Division 6 – Caribbean Stud Poker

1. All references in the Rules to “the Authority” are amended to read “the Secretary”.
2. The reference to substituted rule 11.10(b) in rule 11.6C(d) is deleted and replaced with:

“(b) all Royal Flushes (if any) shall be paid the greater of either:
(i) odds of 10,000 to 1, or
(ii) an equal share (if there are 2 or more Royal Flushes), or the whole (if there is only 1), of the Major Prize Pool, being the amount remaining in the pool after deduction of the payouts (if any) referred to in the preceding subparagraph of this rule.”;

3. Rule 11.9 is deleted and replaced with:

“11.9 Winning progressive jackpot wagers shall, subject to rules 11.10 and 11.11, be paid at the following odds:

| (a) | Royal Flush | 10,000 to 1 or 100% of the major prize pool, whichever is the greater |
| (b) | Straight Flush | 1,000 to 1 or 10% of the jackpot prize pool, whichever is the greater |
| (c) | 4 of a Kind | 500 to 1 |
| (d) | Full House | 150 to 1 |
| (e) | Flush | 100 to 1” |

4. Rule 11.10(c) is deleted and replaced with:

- “(c) all Royal Flushes (if any) shall be paid the greater of either:
- (i) odds of 10,000 to 1, or
 - (ii) equal share (if there are 2 or more Royal Flushes), or the whole (if there is only 1), of the Major Prize Pool, being the amount remaining in the pool after deduction of the payouts (if any) referred to in the preceding subparagraphs of this rule.”
