Any body or person who made a submission or further submission on the Proposed Tuhua District Plan may appeal the Territorial Authority's final decision to the Environment Court on a matter or provision referred to in their submission. Notices of appeal should be in the format of Form 7 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees and Procedure) Regulations 2003 and must be lodged, within 30 working days of service of the Council's decision, with:
